# Homework Guide



United Nations Conventions on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)

Article 28: I have a right to and education

Revised and updated September 2022 in consultation with children, staff and parents of St Machan's Primary

#### Rationale:

As a school we recognise that homework provides our families with opportunities to share, consolidate and discuss learning.

## **Purpose of Homework:**

- Allow practice, reinforcement and consolidation of class work.
- Enable pupils to develop skills of planning and organising their own study time
- Provide an insight into current learning activities for parents/carers
- Provide opportunities for family engagement

Homework is available for every child, and should be completed to the best of their ability, within the time allocation suggested.

### Implementation:

Ideally, homework time should be encouraged as an activity where families can work in a supportive way with their children and provide them with appropriate feedback.

#### Homework is:

- Given out weekly on a Monday with suggested activities for the week. This may be printed or posted on Seesaw/ TEAMS
- Should be submitted via a picture on Seesaw for P1-P6 by Thursday evening if children would like feedback
- P7 should submit their homework via TEAMS
- Reading books should be carried to and from school each day

#### **Time Allocation:**

Children benefit from regular, manageable periods of time spent on homework. This will vary across the week. Staff will set tasks which are age and stage appropriate.

Stage	Time
P1-3	Maximum 15mins/task
P4-7	Maximum 20mins/task

# Types of Homework:

Children will receive a timetable of activities which they can complete throughout the week. This will allow children and parents to have flexibility around clubs and home/life balance and will prepare them as they progress through their academic career.
